1. INTRODUCTION

Present Truth Presentations (PTP) is a Christian foundation that focuses on providing studies through YouTube and PDF format studies. We believe that spreading God's truth of the hour is of great importance, and therefore we have set ourselves the goal of making these studies accessible to everyone. Our foundation is based in Europe and our team consists of driven and passionate individuals who are committed to spreading the message of God to our Seventh-day Adventist brothers and sisters.

1.1 mission

In the coming year, the foundation has set itself the following goal:

Our goal is to enlighten our Advent brothers and sisters of the signs of the times, to make them aware that "the great and dreadful day of the Lord" is at hand, that the purification of the church is soon to take place and that the redemption of the righteous is near.

We do this by spreading **the seven angel's messages** with fellow brothers and sisters.

For that reason the foundation's goal is described in the articles of association as follows:

"to spread the present truth concerning the (repeating of) the angels' messages and the work of reformation of the great Advent movement among Christians, especially Seventh-day Adventists, in order to prepare fellow believers for the second coming of Christ."

2. ACHIEVEMENT

The foundation wants to achieve it's goal by:

- making more free study material available online concerning the present truth;
- supporting international missionary work;
- supporting the headquarter;
- facilitate the holy Feasts;
- Organizing Bible study meetings;
- increase name awareness in order to connect with those Advent brothers and sisters who want to be settled into the present truth (by directing brothers and sisters to the website and YouTube channel);
- Connecting the board with members and members with each other for unity.

3. ACTIVITIES

The following activities are planned for the year 2026:

1. Uploading the studies “the return of the house of Jacob to the promised land” and “last day events” on YouTube;
2. Sponsoring an international missionary trip of two members, to spread the message of the Hour;
3. Facilitate the celebration of the holy Feasts and invite brothers and sisters to join; Accommodation will be booked on Pesach, Pentecost and Sukkot day 1;
4. Several Bible studies on the Sabbath, which focus is mainly on third division Adventism;
5. Every Friday evening we open the Sabbath with members online and discuss the Sabbath school Lesson;
6. A minimum of 2 informal group activities;
7. A minimum of 2 formal member meetings;
8. A minimum of 2 newsletters.

4. ORGANISATION

Board

Each board member has it's own task. The board members advise each other mutually. The board members have a formal board meeting at least twice a year. Voting takes place without any restrictions. A decision is adopted when there is a majority. A cost-benefit analysis is performed annually. An annual report of the activities is also published on the website.

In addition to the board, the foundation also has a number of highly dedicated members who help organize activities and advise the board. The foundation depends on the commitment and help of its members.

The board tries to have a members' meeting every six months in which members can provide feedback, input and contribute ideas. During the meeting, members can also indicate what they would like to contribute in the following period.

5. FINANCES

The foundation acquires its income by receiving tithes and offerings. According to the Spirit of Prophecy the tithes can only be used to support evangelists, missionary workers and ministers. However, according to the articles of association, board members may not be paid a salary.

For this reason, the tithes are spent on:

1. travel expenses for evangelists;
2. volunteer allowances for evangelists;
3. donations for missionary work;
4. costs necessary to carry out evangelism work.

All other expenses are paid from the offerings, such as the costs of accommodations for the Feasts and the purchase of office supplies.

Two board members receive a volunteer allowance and the third has decided to waive it.

The foundation is a PBO (Public Benefit Organisation) and is therefore permitted to raise funds.

An annual statement of income and expenditure is submitted on the appropriate tax form.
